## **FACT SHEET**

### **RESORT OVERVIEW:**

**Chateau on the Lake Resort & Spa** is widely regarded as one of the Midwest's finest resorts. Featuring a beautiful setting on a forested Ozark mountaintop overlooking Missouri's scenic Table Rock Lake, the 301-room resort is Branson's only AAA Four-Diamond resort, having captured the prestigious award for the past 10 consecutive years. Offering something to please virtually anyone, the resort features a wealth of on-site recreational options, award-winning dining, and beautifully-appointed guest rooms and suites, along with an ideal location convenient to the array of offerings of popular Branson, widely regarding as the "Live Music Show Capital of America."

Recreational options at the resort include the impressive 14,000-square-foot Spa Chateau, a 24-hour fitness center, two lighted tennis courts, a year-round indoor pool, an outdoor (seasonal) pool, indoor and outdoor hot tubs, nature and biking trails, the 54-seat Sassafras Movie Theatre, Crawdaddies Kids Klub, and full-service concierge. In addition, the resort's full-service marina offers more water sports activities than many other resorts in the Midwest, enabling guests to enjoy Table Rock Lake's 800 miles of shoreline and pristine waters.

### **LOCATION:**

Surrounded by the stunning Ozark Mountains, Chateau on the Lake Resort & Spa is located at the junction of Highways 265 and 165, near Table Rock Dam and the Showboat Branson Belle. The address is 415 North State Highway 265, Branson, Missouri 65616.

The resort is conveniently located just 10 miles from the new Branson Airport offering low fare flights arriving daily. As well as many area airports, including the, Boone County Regional Airport in Harrison, Arkansas (which is 39 miles), and Springfield-Branson Regional (which is 47 miles).

The impressive new Branson Airport, which will open in May 2009, is expected to significantly increase the number of new visitors to the area. The airport, the first privately financed and operated commercial airport in the United States, will be able to accommodate all types of commercial aircraft ranging from regional jets to Boeing 767's.

### **ACCOMMODATIONS:**

The resort offers 301 beautifully-appointed spacious guest rooms and suites, which feature cherry wood beds, down comforters, tiled stone baths, dual-line telephones with data port, WiFi access (at a nominal fee), iron and full-sized ironing board, coffee maker, in-room movies and music (at a nominal fee), hair dryers, lighted makeup mirror, 37 inch flat screen televisions and in-room safes. Accommodation options include Traditional, Deluxe, oversized Chateau Kings, and 57 spacious suites.

Suite options include sizeable Ambassador Suites, elegant Vice Presidential Suites, and two luxurious Presidential Suites. The Vice Presidential Suites offer private living and sleeping areas separated by beautiful French doors, with a grand four-poster king-size bed. The exclusive 1,000-square-foot Presidential Suites provide breathtaking views of Table Rock Lake from two top floor balconies, as well as a hand-carved four-poster king-size bed, and a two-person Jacuzzi™ shower with a waterfall showerhead.

The resort also features select pet-friendly rooms for pets less than 25 pounds.

### **RECREATIONAL OFFERINGS**

Among the resort's diverse recreational offerings is the impressive 14,000-square-foot, full-service **Spa Chateau**, which features 10 luxurious treatment rooms, customized body treatments, a soothing Infinity Tub that is filled from the ceiling, a decadent Roman Bath situated beneath a waterfall overlooking Table Rock Lake, a lake-view Movement Studio for yoga, a unique Barber Spa, lounges, men's and women's locker rooms, saunas, steam rooms, three pedicure stations, four manicure stations, and a two-story waterfall in the lobby.

The resort's **Chateau on the Lake Marina**, open most of the year, offers more water sports activities than most other resorts in the Midwest. Offerings at the full-service marina include an array of watercraft rentals, which includes ski boats, fishing boats, waverunners, catamarans, paddle boats, sea kayaks and canoes. Parasailing, guided fishing excursions, scuba diving, and snorkeling are among the many other available options. With over 800 miles of shoreline and pristine water, Table Rock Lake is a perfect water playground for guests.

**Additional recreational offerings** at the resort include a 24-hour fitness center, two lighted tennis courts, a year-round indoor pool, an outdoor (seasonal) pool, indoor and outdoor hot tubs, nature and biking trails, The Sassafras Movie Theater, Crowdaddies Kids Club (for children ages 4-12), The Castle Playground, and full-service concierge.

**Golf** at six area courses, which includes three of Missouri's finest, is also available to guests. Among the options are Branson Creek Golf Club, Ledgestone Country Club and the new Payne Stewart Golf club.

### **DINING OPTIONS**

Dining options at Chateau on the Lake Resort & Spa include the award-winning Chateau Grille, which is known for its elegant presentation, exceptional cuisine, and beautiful views. Casual fare options include: the 9<sup>th</sup> Street Italian Deli, serving bistro-style sandwiches, hand-made pizza, and "to go" box lunches; the Atrium Café & Wine Bar, located in the lobby beside an indoor waterfall and stream; and The Sweet Shoppe, offering hand-dipped ice cream, baked goods, candies, and specialty coffees.

## **LOUNGES**

Guests have many options for places to unwind, which includes the Atrium Café & Wine Bar, and the newly-renovated Library Lounge, which provides an intimate atmosphere and a picturesque great stone fireplace.

## **RESORT OFFERINGS**

Additional features at Chateau on the Lake Resort & Spa include an impressive 10-story sky-lit atrium that provides breathtaking vistas of the lake, lush gardens, and surrounding mountains, and which features meandering streams brimming with colorful Koi fish.

## **MEETING FACILITIES**

The resort boasts one of Missouri's largest convention centers, with 43,500 square feet of flexible meeting space, and the ability to host groups of 10 to 3,000. The resort also features many scenic outdoor venues too.

Offerings include the impressive 32,000-square-foot Great Hall, 19 meeting rooms, 3 corporate board rooms, a private 54-seat theater for special presentations, high-speed internet access, and WiFi in pre-function areas.
