"Not only does the resort have an exceptional spa and a wonderful setting, but it features a wealth of recreational offerings on-site, and is also very convenient to the diverse entertainment offerings of Branson."

Among the recreational offerings at the resort is the impressive 14,000-square-foot Spa Chateau. The full-service spa features 10 luxurious treatment rooms; customized body treatments; a soothing Infinity Tub that is filled from the ceiling; an opulent Roman Bath situated beneath a waterfall overlooking Table Rock Lake; a lake-view Movement Therapy Studio for Yoga; and a unique Barber Spa.

In addition to the Grand Chateau Massage, Spa Chateau offers such services as Table Rock Hot Stone Massage, Chateau Dogwood Signature Body Treatment, Fall Creek Deep Tissue Massage, Reflexology Foot Massage, Rockaway Salt Scrub, Detox Wrap, Chateau Dogwood Signature Facial, Classic Facial, Headache and Sinus Massage, Gentleman's Facial, and Table Rock Manicure. For men, Spa Chateau also offers such authentic barber services as Chateau Dogwood Signature Shave and Facial Treatment, Traditional Hot Lather Shave, and Men's Barber Cut.

The resort's Chateau on the Lake Marina, open most of the year, offers more water sports activities than any other resort in the Midwest. Offerings at the full-service marina include overnight boat slips, and an array of watercraft rentals, which includes ski boats, fishing boats, waverunners, catamarans, paddle boats, sea kayaks, and canoes. Parasailing, guided fishing excursions, scuba diving, and snorkeling are among the many other available options. With 850 miles of pristine shoreline and 80 miles of crystal blue water, Table Rock Lake is a perfect water playground.
