“Chateau on the Lake is very popular for Girls’ Getaways because it is a great place to relax, be pampered, *and* have fun,” said Stephen Marshall, vice president and general manager of the 301-room resort. “Not only does the resort have an exceptional spa and a wonderful setting, but it features a wealth of recreational offerings on-site, and is very convenient to the diverse entertainment offerings of Branson.”

Among the recreational offerings at the resort is the impressive 14,000-square-foot Spa Chateau. The full-service spa features 10 luxurious treatment rooms; customized body treatments; a soothing Infinity Tub that is filled from the ceiling; an opulent Roman Bath situated beneath a waterfall overlooking Table Rock Lake; a lake-view Movement Therapy Studio for Yoga; and a unique Barber Spa.

The resort’s Chateau on the Lake Marina, open most of the year, offers more water sports activities than any other resort in the Midwest.
